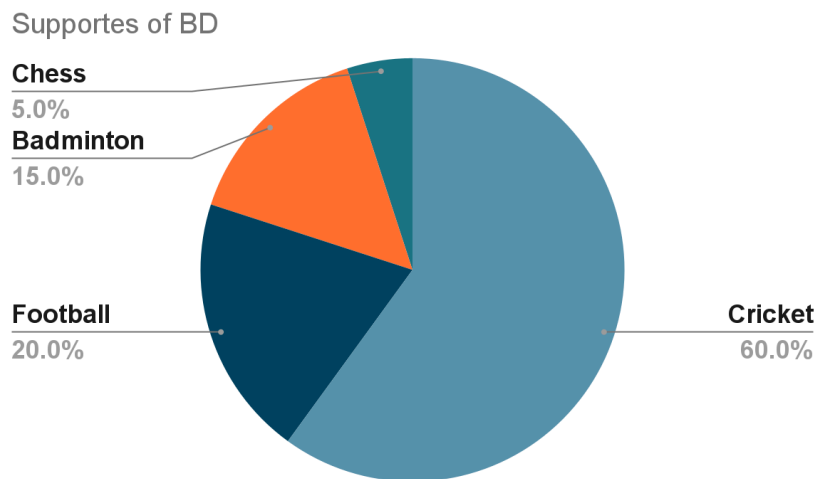


The pie chart below shows how divided BD supporters are in terms of sports.



The Pie-chart

The given chart represents/illustrates/shows the percentage of supporters of different games of Bangladesh, and it is divided in four/five categories : X,Y,Z.

According to the chart/ at a glance, it is seen that (part) contributes/holds/partakes the highest percentage of (Topic) and it is/which is (Rate) . On the other hand/On the contrary, (part) accounts for/keeps the lowest percentage which is/and it is (Rate).
